**FRESHWATER FISH PERMIT APPLICATION FORM**
**WESTERN CAPE NATURE CONSERVATION BOARD PERMIT APPLICATION TO IMPORT/EXPORT/  
 TRANSPORT/STOCK LIVE FISHES**

Western Cape Nature Conservation Laws Amendment Act no 3 of 2000 (incorporating Nature Conservation Ordinance 19 of 1974)

**PERMIT APPLICATION NOTES**

1. Permits must adhere to regulations listed in the above-mentioned Act and any associated official fish policies and guidelines.
2. CapeNature will add permit conditions as deemed relevant.
3. Permits will not be approved if the species is on the PROHIBITED LIST.
4. Permits to stock alien fishes will not be approved in areas that are within a CapeNature priority fish conservation zone. Indigenous fishes may only be stocked into dams and rivers as part of an approved CapeNature conservation programme.
5. Zones for invasive alien species (e.g. carp, bass, rainbow trout etc.) are in the process of being developed. Once completed and approved, such species may only be stocked within approved zones.
6. Site visits may be required by designated CapeNature staff to ensure that fish stockings are environmentally acceptable.
7. Fish may only be stocked in the water bodies indicated on this application form and on the associated permit.
8. Please include a map (1:50 000) showing clearly the water bodies to be stocked. The co-ordinates of the water body to be stocked **MUST** be included in the application.
9. Permits will not be issued if the permit application is not completed in full.
10. Applications not accompanied by a proof of payment of the R100.00 cannot be processed. Please ensure that the **reference number** is indicated on the proof of payment.
11. No export permits will be issued without a copy of the relevant import permit.
12. Permit applications usually take a minimum of three days to be processed. More complex applications can take several weeks, including site inspections.
